Craig M. Cogut Dissertation Fellowship in Latin American & Caribbean Studies 2010-2011

The Center for Latin American & Caribbean Studies announces a twelve-month dissertation fellowship for graduate students at Brown University who are in the writing stage of their dissertation. The fellowships are open to students in any department whose dissertation is directly relevant to Latin America and/or the Caribbean. The awards consist of a \$19,000 stipend and payment of enrollment and health fees. Applications will be evaluated by a committee comprised of core faculty of the Center for Latin American & Caribbean Studies and a representative of the Graduate School.

Interested applicants should submit:

- (1) Cover sheet with name, department, box number, home address and telephone number, and dissertation title.
- (2) Brief (2-3 page) description of the dissertation topic.
- (3) Summary of progress made on the dissertation up to the current date.
- (4) Precise timetable for the twelve-month period covered by the fellowship.
- (5) CV
- (6) Three letters of support, including one from the chair of the applicant's dissertation committee.

Applicants should submit four copies of items (1) through (5) to the Center for Latin American & Caribbean Studies, Watson Institute for International Studies, 111 Thayer Street, Providence, RI, 02912. Letters of support may be mailed directly to the Center or they can be submitted in a sealed and signed envelope with the application materials.

Applications for the 2010-2011 academic year are due at the Center for Latin American & Caribbean Studies **no later than March 1, 2010**
